Ethical Guidelines for Authors Content

- All authors must declare they have read and agreed to the content of the submitted manuscript.
- Ethics Manuscripts may be rejected by the editorial office if it is felt that the work was not carried out within an ethical framework.
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- Plagiarism in any form constitutes a serious violation of the most basic principles of scholarship and cannot be tolerated. Examples of plagiarism include:
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- Engineering writers, or anyone else who assisted in the preparation of the manuscript, should be acknowledged in the manuscript, either as an author, or in the Acknowledgements section.
- Authors should list their source of funding and/or employer as appropriate.
